If this is your dog's first ASFA trial - you must include the signed ASFA Certification or Waiver (not required for an entry in Singles). You must also include a photocopy of acceptable registry (except for NGA). Your hound must have a registration number, or your entry will NOT be accepted.

Awards: Ribbons –1st, blue; 2nd, red; 3rd, yellow; 4th, white; NBQ, green; BOB, purple & gold rosette; BIF, red, white & blue rosette .

Trial Hours: 7:00 am until completion.

Roll Call & Inspection for all breeds: 8:30 AM Eastern Time. Worker's dogs may be roll-called early.

Late, incomplete, conditional, unsigned, unpaid entries and entries without a registration number will NOT be accepted. Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail. Substitutes for lame or in-season hounds will be allowed if substitute has the same owner and the trial secretary is notified before the close of day-of-trial entries.

Breeds & Eligibility: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnecho dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Whippets, provisional breeds, if any, may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited stake breeds, if any, may be entered in Limited Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polskis, Galgo Españols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengos and Silken Windhounds.

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the United Kennel Club, the National Greyhound Association, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of Desert Bred Salukis (SPDBS). Limited and/or Provisional stake entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the National Greyhound Registry.

Regular Stakes Offered:

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound who has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record. A photocopy of the hound's registration must be submitted at the hound's first trial. This is waived for NGA greyhounds

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age exceeds six years, except Irish Wolfhounds, whose age shall exceed five years and Whippets, Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Afghan Hounds whose age shall exceed seven years, who has met certification requirements. Points earned in this stake are towards the V-FCH or V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE for Chart Polskis, Galgo Espanols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengo & Silken Windhounds who have met certification requirements.

SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including novice hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications and/or hounds that have been disqualified from competition in other stakes, are eligible to enter. Not eligible for Best of Breed Competition. Entry for Singles Stake limited to 10 Hounds each day.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered on Sunday only.

Conditions of Entry: All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial. If the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more, the stakes will be split into flights by public random draw Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered; hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Hound certification runs will be offered after completion of the trial on Saturday.

There will be a \$5.00 fine for any loose hounds on the field which are not in the course in process.

.....DIRECTIONS.....

From I-77: From either the north or south, exit at Rout 82 (Royalton Road) and head east. Name changes to Chippewa Road east of Route 21 and then changes again to Aurora Road once you cross over the bridge and enter Summit County. Just past the bridge, make a left on to Chaffee Road and go until it dead ends into Valley View Road. Make a right and the park entrance will be approximately one mile on the right just across from the Police Station.

From the OH turnpike: Exit at Route 8 heading northbound. Go approximately 4 1/4 miles to the main intersection of Route 82 (E. Aurora Road). Continue north another 1/4 mile to the next intersection which is Valley View Road and make a left. Follow Valley View Road two miles to the park entrance which is on the left, just across from the Police Station.

From I-271: Exit at Route 8 northbound. Go approximately 1 1/4 miles to the main intersection of Route 82 (E. Aurora Road). Continue north another 1/4 mile to the next intersection which is Valley View Road and make a left. Follow Valley View Road two miles to the park entrance which is on the left, just across from the Police Station.

The perimeter road in the park is ONE WAY, so please keep to the right after entering the park. The coursing field is about half way around in the back area of the park just past ball diamonds 3 & 4. The parking area is not shaded. Park rules do not allow alcoholic beverages on the grounds. **PLEASE PARK ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS OFF OF THE PERIMETER ROAD. WE HAVE SPACE FOR THREE TRAILORS OR MOTORHOMES. YOU MUST CONTACT THE FTC IN ADVANCE OF THE TRIAL IF YOU WANT ONE OF THESE SPACES. AVAILABILITY WILL BE ON A FIRST COME BASIS, NO FEE, NO HOOK UPS.** No other overnight camping will be allowed. There is a Walmart within three miles of the field that may be used for overnight motor home parking.

.....Emergency Vet Information.....

Vet On Call Saturday until 1:00 PM. Brecksville Veterinary Hospital, 13019 Chippewa Road, Brecksville, OH 44141, 440-526-8350. Exit park by making a left onto Valley View Road going west. Go approximately 1/2 mile to Chaffee Road, make a left. Take Chaffee until it dead ends into Route 82 (E. Aurora Road), make a right. Hospital is just across the bridge on the right, just before the intersection of Riverview Road.

24 hour Emergency Care: Metropolitan Veterinary Hospital, 1053 S. Cleveland-Massillon Road, Copley, Ohio, 44321, 330-666-2976. This is a state of the art, 24/7 vet clinic that lis about 30 minutes from the field.

Alternate 24 hour Emergency Pet Clinic: Dr. Hart's Emergency Vet Clinic, 25780 Miles Road, Bedford, Ohio, 44146, 216-464-2298 This clinic is only fifteen minutes from the field, is not quite as sophisticated as the above clinic, but provides very good basic emergency care.

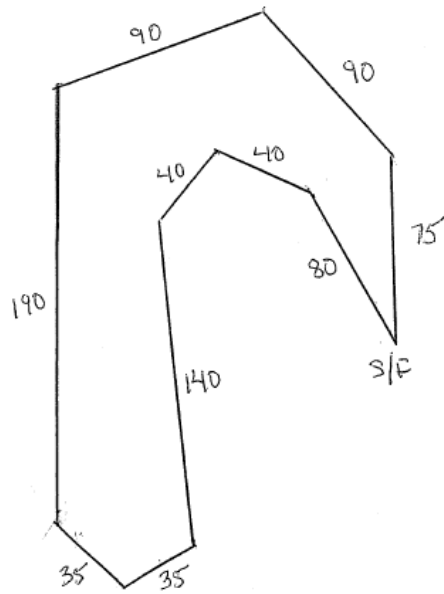

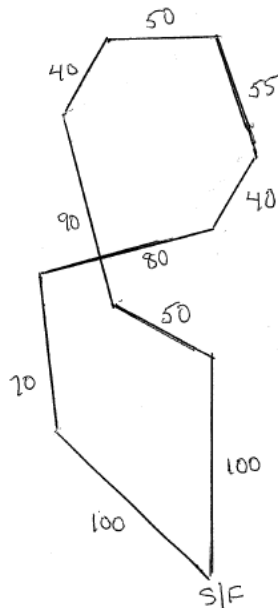

The field is not fenced, but the course is well away from the main road.

RESTAURANTS AND STORES

There are a wide variety of restaurants in and around the Macedonia Commons Plaza which can be found on Route 82, between Route 8 and I-271. The Commons also has a wide range of stores, including a Walmart .
